



If you're the fluff you can cut. But team building is an investment, not an expense. It breaks down walls and fosters a thinking, "Who's got time for self-improvement when I'm sense of unity. Ah, the comfort zone—the place where nothing ever grows. Artificial harmony might make life feel cozy, but


